# MUSEUM OF FINE ARTS



The Museum of Fine Arts is located near the City Park and the Heroes' Square. This eclectic building was designed in neoclassical style, with influences from the Italian Renaissance. Over the imposing main staircases eight Corinthian pillars are carrying a huge tympanum. Various styles characterize the interior halls, which can accommodate up to 750 guests.

## EUROPA BOAT

The boat slowly descends on the Danube passing the illuminated highlights of the city. From the river you can discover another aspect of the shining beauties of Budapest. The boat was built in the middle of the last century but its original look was kept during the recent renovation. Its interior fully meets today's requirements, both in its design, as in its technology. The imposing hall of 661 m<sup>2</sup> on the main deck and two halls (122 and 139 m<sup>2</sup>) on the upper deck have a capacity to accommodate up to 1.000 guests and in addition there is also a covered promenade deck of 320 m<sup>2</sup> on the same level. The 320 m<sup>2</sup> panorama bridge provides a 360 ° view of the fascinating landscape of the river Danube.





## GELLERT SPA – AULA



Gellért Bath was built in 1918 at the foot of Gellért Mountain. This is the best hot spa in Budapest where one can admire the original Art Nouveau interior, coloured mosaics, marble columns, stained glass windows and statues. History and unique atmosphere, inimitable atmosphere for a gala dinner for 350 people or 400 people for cocktail reception.



## RESTAURANT GUNDEL

Gundel is considered a national monument of the Hungarian cuisine. Located in a beautiful house at the entrance of the City Park, the restaurant owes its reputation to its inimitable hospitality and incomparable cuisine. Its unique and authentic setting is enhanced by the paintings of the most remarkable Hungarian artists exposed all over the rooms. The restaurant has many luxuriously decorated rooms, the largest with a capacity for a gala dinner for 160 people, or a cocktail reception for 320 people and a conference for 200 people.





## CAFE GERBEAUD

Founded by the Swiss confectioner Emile Gerbeaud in 1882, the Gerbeaud Coffee House is one of the top confectionaries in downtown. The plans for the interior decoration of the café were completed by the artisan Henrik Darilek in the year 1910. Fine woods, marble and bronze were used. For the interior design the ceilings were decorated with rococo plaster work in Louis XV style; the chandeliers and wall lamps were created in Maria Theresa Style. Gerbeaud had secessionist style tables sent from the Paris World Fair so that the elegant ambience would be perfect. Its gorgeous display offer endless choices of delicious pastries and sweets. Gerbeaud has several rooms, the largest with a capacity of 144 pax for gala dinner and cocktail reception for 250 pax.



## ROYAL PALACE OF GÖDÖLLŐ



The Royal Castle of Gödöllő is the largest Baroque castle in Hungary. Built in the eighteenth century by the Grassykovich family, then offered by the Hungarian state as a coronation present to Emperor Franz Joseph and Empress Elisabeth (Sissi). The royal family visited quite often the palace and it became Sissi's favourite summer residence. The splendour of its original restored areas allows it to accommodate ceremonies of the highest level. The castle has several rooms - Ceremony Room, Baroque Theatre, Baroque Stable, etc. The largest of them can accommodate 350 people for gala dinner, 400 people for cocktail reception and 300 people for conference.

## SZABÓ ERVIN MUNICIPAL LIBRARY

The library is located in a beautiful neo-baroque palace which belonged to a Hungarian noble family Wenckheim. The building was constructed between 1886 and 1891. The beautiful reading rooms are located on the top floor of the building and reminds us to those times when this was the meeting place of the Hungarian nobility of Budapest. The library stands in the heart of "the palace district," in the eighth district of Budapest, in which the Hungarian nobles of the capital lived. The library offers a variety of rooms, 90 people for gala dinner and 150 people for a cocktail reception.



## VAM DESIGN CENTER

Vam Design Center opened in 2007 is a complex possessing Central Europe's largest exhibition space. It is a four-story building offering 5.000 m<sup>2</sup> exhibition and event space to its clients. This building welcomes professional and commercial fairs, conferences, concerts and is an excellent venue place for gala dinners as well. The ground floor (atrium) with a capacity of 1.800 m<sup>2</sup> and its very unique design can be an ideal place for your event.





A small piece of old Budapest. Elegant, aristocratic atmosphere in the center of Budapest, in one of the most beautiful palaces of Budapest. A Neo-Renaissance style building, reflecting the time of the famous balls. Offers several rooms, the largest with a capacity of 120 people for a gala dinner and 300 people for a cocktail reception.



## HUNGARIAN RAILWAY MUSEUM

The museum is a unique event venue place in the world with approximately 70.000 m<sup>2</sup>. Its unique atmosphere is guaranteed by the historical collection of railway vehicles (over 100 vehicles), the beautiful environment and the nostalgic feeling. The building was built with a combination of steel and concrete with an inner measuring up over 15m. The largest hall, for at least 1.500 people for gala dinner, 2.500 people for cocktail reception or conference. The property can be reached by nostalgic train as well.





# LÁZÁR EQUESTRIAN PARK



The equestrian park belongs to the Lazar brothers - world champions in carriage driving – situated 35 km far from Budapest, close to Gödöllő, in the picturesque Domony valley. The main attraction of this wonderful center is the horse show where one can see the proof that “Hungarians are a nation born with horses”. The park is the ideal place for a gala dinner with typical Hungarian dishes. There are three separate rooms offering a total capacity of 680 people for a tasty dinner.
